Mr. Powell is also doing a presentation for each class so they know what to do in an ALICE drill. Students will practice evacuating the building and getting safely to our reunification location.

#### **Evacuate**



- You have permission to evacuate if it is safe to do so
- When leaving:
  - · Leave all belongings behind
  - Take your "Go Bucket" with you

- Once outside of the building proceed to the rally point
- Once at the rally point take attendance and report anyone not with you

The reunification location is where our families would come to pick up students should a real event like this ever take place. Our reunification location for Steel is at the end of the athletic field at the end of the school property. In the unlikely event that an incident would ever take place, students could reunite with their families on Creighton Avenue once it was deemed safe by the authorities. Students are encouraged to participate in this ALICE drill, but it is not mandatory. If your student is feeling anxious about taking part, please let Mr. Powell know so we can have them sit out or act as an observer for this drill.
